Garden Guides conduct boat, tram, walking and special event tours.

You must be 18 years of age or older, possess a valid driver's license and be able to lift 50 lbs. You must also enjoy working with people and speaking to large groups.

Garden Teachers teach programs, lead children's birthday parties and scout programs, orient visitors in WOW Children's garden and lead "discovery cart" activities.

Must have a flexible schedule and be available some weekends.  
Bachelors Degree and experience teaching in a formal or an  
Informal setting is required.

Toll Booth and Front Desk Attendants work directly with the public and use  
a computerized ticketing and schedule system. Excellent  
communication and phone skills are required. Attendants  
greet, direct and assist visitors to plan their time at the  
garden.

You must enjoy working with people and be responsible for  
handling financial transactions.

Gardeners maintain display beds by watering, weeding, pruning, fertilizing,  
planting and more.

Must be able to lift 50 lbs, operate gas powered tools and work for
