

**Activity # 1: Match the bird to what it would eat. Use its beak as a clue!**



A. Blue Heron

“I fly from flower to flower sucking nectar through my long, thin beak.”



B. Bald Eagle

“I like to ‘fish’ all day. I stand in the water or on the shoreline and when a fish swims by I catch it with my long beak.”



C. Cardinal

“My beak is specially designed for hunting animals including my favorite food-fish. The hook on my beak is used to tear meat.”



D. Woodpecker

“I use my strong sharp beak to bore holes into tree trunks to catch the insects underneath.”



E. Hummingbird

“Sometimes I eat insects, but usually I use my small, strong beak to crack seeds and eat berries.”
